Biography:

Malorie Flon is the Executive Director of the Institut du Nouveau Monde (INM), Québec's leading non-partisan organization dedicated to strengthening democracy through public participation and civic engagement.

Over the past fifteen years, she has led and contributed to more than one hundred public participation and consultation initiatives, helping citizens engage in discussions on a wide range of public policy issues. Throughout her career, she has played a key role in advancing the professional practice of public participation in Québec while supporting municipalities, government ministries, professional orders, healthcare and educational institutions, and public organizations in developing more inclusive and participatory decision-making processes.

She has directed major initiatives, including the citizen forums of the Laurent Commission and the public consultations of the Advisory Committee on Policing Reality for Québec's Ministry of Public Security. Since 2021, she has been a Dialogue Associate with the Morris J. Wosk Centre for Dialogue at Simon Fraser University. She was appointed Executive Director of the INM in May 2022 after serving the organization in several leadership roles over the previous twelve years.
