Biography:

A native of Montreal, Justice Manon Savard was admitted to the Quebec Bar in 1986 after studying law at the Université de Montréal and business administration at McGill University. Prior to her appointment to the judiciary, she practised law for 23 years, specializing in employment and labour law as well as administrative law. She also taught at the École de formation professionnelle of the Quebec Bar and authored numerous publications in the field of employment and labour law.

Appointed to the Superior Court of Quebec in 2009, she joined the Court of Appeal of Quebec in 2013. In June 2020, she became the 21st Chief Justice of Quebec, a position she held until 2026, when she chose to continue serving on the Court as a supernumerary judge.
